Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston and President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), says that he will continue to advocate for permanent relief from congress on issues of critical importance to people of faith. “Religious freedom is a fundamental right that should be upheld by all branches of government and not subject to political whims,” he says. Cardinal DiNardo met with President Trump in early May to address First Amendment rights of the church that have been ignored under Obamacare.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

One of the first steps that need to be taken in the merging of St. Ann and St. Gabriel parishes into the new St. Raphael parish is an adjustment of the existing Mass schedule. As required by the Archdiocese, a new schedule must be up and running THAT IS PHYSICALLY DOABLE for one priest. The weekend of July 1 & 2 one priest should be able to do all the masses necessary (Max of 4 for the weekend) at the two locations. A group of five representatives from each of the current parishes met with Fr. John and the Deacons on Tuesday night. It was decided that the new schedule would be this:
